




Amcom – 1992 – Ongoing

Department of Defence - 2011

 Construction of a 25 kilometre communications network around the Army Training Facility at Bindoon, Western Australia.

Challenges included;

- Environmental working in native bush with protected flora and fauna
- OH&S working on a live firing range with complex site requirements
- Majority of work in rock ground conditions.

Main Roads Western Australia - 2011

Kwinana Freeway Widening Project – This project required the realignment of an existing fibre optic cable which conflicted with the proposed new lane construction. 5,000m of new conduit was installed to allow for the relocation of approximately 30,000m of fibre optic cable. This included multiple new installations under the existing freeway structures and the Perth to Mandurah railway line.

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
